# **During The Competition**

#### You May . . .

- Clap and cheer before, between and after but not during the competition songs.
- Support the contestants with cheers while evaluation is not ongoing. Evaluation of quartets starts as soon as the quartet enters the stage and continues until they exit the stage. Evaluation of choruses starts when the stage lights are turned on and continues until the stage lights are turned off. The judges may continue writing for some time after the evaluation has been finalized.
- Talk and move around in the performance hall between performances.
- Have fun and enjoy what you see and hear.

#### But You May Not . . .

- Make any recordings or take photographs. The use of all photography, audio, video or movie recording equipment is prohibited.
- Enter and exit the performance hall during a performance.
- Sing between the performances.
- Have your mobile devices turned on mobile phones may interfere with the sound recording even if they are put in silent or flight mode.


#### Also Remember . . .

- Sit close to an exit if you are bringing children with you. If the child starts to cry, exit as quickly as possible.
- Please honor the VIP seating area, as well as other designed areas.
- Violators of these rules will be escorted from the competition area.

#### **Open Division & Audience Choice Award**

In 2014, Sweet Adelines International introduced Open Division, which is a competition alternative to International Division or Evaluation Only, and available to both choruses and quartets. Open Division contestants present an entertainment package, which may be up to 10 minutes long. The package must contain one competition song/medley, at least one more song (although often there are more), and a script or emcee comments that integrate the music and the story. The Open Division contestant's package typically includes fun, clever and often innovative costumes for the members, thereby contributing to the overall effectiveness of the package. Open Division contest performances are adjudicated in the areas of Musicality, Unity, Theme/Emcee/Microphone Technique, Creativity and Communication.

Skyline Harmony Chorus will annually present the "Skyline Harmony Chorus Open Division Chorus Award" and the "Skyline Harmony Chorus Open Division Quartet Award." These awards to Open Division contestants (choruses and quartets) will serve to recognize and honor the time, effort, skill, and creativity required to design and perform an Open Division entertainment package. If the chorus competition, or quartet competition, includes two or more Open Division contestants, the award will be presented to the Audience Choice Award winner. The Audience Choice Award is strictly based on the entertainment value of the packages. 50 randomly selected members of the audience vote for their favorite performance among the Open Division competitors.

**Sound: Kim Vaughn** Kim Vaughn is a three-time International Quartet Champion and Queen of Harmony. (High Society (1976), Savvy (1988) and A Cappella Gold (2001)). She is a Certified Sound Judge, Master Sweet Adelines International Faculty member, and a member of the Region 21 Hall of Fame. Kim's renowned accomplishments in competitive Barbershop include receiving the 2014 Sweet Adelines International Lifetime Achievement Award and a Master Director 700 designation. Kim served as musical director of the San Diego Chorus from 1985 - 2014. Kim remains an active member of the San Diego Chorus and currently sings with Director's Cut quartet.

**Music:** Jan Meyer Jan Meyer, a long time member of Sweet Adelines, joined Heartland Harmony in the winter of 1981. She later joined City Chorus in Indianapolis, where she sang and served for over 25 years in nearly every chorus leadership position. In 2007 Jan became a member of Spirit of the Gulf Acappella Chorus. She is now a Certified Music Judge and Approved Music Arranger. Jan has sung in two quartets that earned top 5 regional medals a total of 7 times. She received the 1999 Sweet Adelines/MENC (now NAfTME) Award for contributions to music education. Jan is the only person to receive this award who wasn't a professional music educator.

**Expression: Vickie Maybury** (Panel Chair) Master 700 Director Vickie Maybury is a highly sought-after coach known for helping singers "find their voices" through a highly engaging teaching style. Vickie serves as the Expression Category Specialist, on the Sweet Adelines International Board of Directors, is a Certified Expression Judge, and is Certified International Faculty. Vickie has been the Denver-based Skyline Chorus's musical director since 1984. Inspired by her exceptional leadership, Skyline has ranked in the top 10 Sweet Adelines International choruses since 2004. Vickie's greatest joy is celebrating the successes of those she is privileged to work with.

**Visual Communication: Diane Porsch** A music major and graduate of the University of Dubuque, Iowa, and the University of Wisconsin, Oshkosh, Diane Porsch is a Certified Visual Communications Judge Specialist and International Faculty member. Diane's musical leadership journey began with her role as Master Director of The Fox Valley Chorus Region 6 and continued with The Riverport Chorus Region 3. Since 1999, Diane has been the director of the Buffalo Gateway Show Chorus Region 17. Diane's contributions to Sweet Adelines go beyond directing. She has served as Secretary of the International Board of Directors, a member of the Education Direction Committee, Moderator of the International Faculty Coordinators, and chair of the 2003 International Educational Symposium.

As a member of Sweet Adelines for 23 years, she has been involved in chorus leadership administratively & musically, regional leadership on the Management Team & Convention Team, and has been in several quartets. 
